- Lab test results will be mailed directly to the patient, not the patient's physician. Patients are encouraged to share the results with their healthcare provider.
- If results are critical, we will attempt to notify you as soon as possible using the telephone number that you provided. You should notify your physician immediately.

The laboratory results of Direct Access Testing (DAT) require additional expert interpretation and do not substitute for medical advice, diagnosis, or treatment, which should be based on your physician's professional judgment, including his/her review of your test results, the findings of physical examination, and the review of your personal and family medical history. DAT laboratory results are not sent to your physician. You are responsible for distribution of your reports to your physician and for scheduling a follow-up appointment to discuss your results with your physician.
